CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Area C – St Michael's Church

The piling work at Area C is now complete. The next stage of work in this area involves cropping the piles to the correct height in readiness for installation of the capping beam to form the wall. Pitching works on the river bed will recommence at the end of February – river conditions permitting.



The existing wall is being broken down at bridge end and the precast concrete units installed. Stone masonry works will then follow.

Area D – Cragg Brook & Calder Confluence

The masonry works to the new flood defence walls is almost complete at Streamside Fold. Demolition of the timber sheds along New Road is now underway.



Area E – Caldene Bridge

Piling work for the bridge is complete, with the central pier piles currently being cropped in preparation for the capping beam. The bridge beams will be the next stage of construction in this area.

Area F – Upstream of Caldene Bridge

Piling will commence shortly to form the flood defence wall from the end of Calder Grove upstream.

Area G – Cragg Brook

Landscaping is now complete in this area.
