CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Area D – River Calder/Cragg Brook confluence

The photographs below show the damaged wall at the confluence of the River Calder and Cragg (Elphin) Brook. A concrete base was installed at the base of the wall where scour damage has occurred. A reinforced sprayed concrete facing has been applied and grout injected into the voids. Natural stone cladding will complete this section of repair works.



Area E – Caldene Bridge

Following the removal of the bridge deck, the demolition of Caldene Bridge was completed last week. The beams were lifted out in pairs by crane (photos below). The completion of these works now enables the new piled flood defence wall to be installed from Streamside Fold to the new bridge.



Area F – White Houses

Installation of glass panels to the new flood defence wall at the rear of properties at White Houses is now underway, as contractors install the fittings for the panels this week. We will be removing the temporary concrete barriers to enable installation of the new kerbs and install copings to the new wall between White Houses and Hawksclough from 6 July. These works will be carried out from 7pm to 7am for up to five nights and will require a lane closure. Traffic lights will be in place for a short section of the road. In light of other road closures now being in place, the decision was made to close one lane of Burnley Road overnight when traffic is lighter. We will endeavour to keep any noisy works to the early part of the evening to keep disruption to a minimum where possible.
