

Dear Resident,

As I write to you, it is now 16 years since I was first selected as the Conservative candidate to fight the General Election in the Calder Valley (March 2007) and I can tell you it has been a great honour to serve you as residents, and our country too.

A lot of people talk about Levelling Up, and it is fantastic what an example the the constituency has become. Around £1.1 billion has been spent in Calder Valley, including infrastructure and support during the pandemic. The many projects I'm proud to have lobbied for and knocked on many doors in Whitehall to achieve include much-needed flood infrastructure spend which continues; the massive ongoing hospital reconfiguration; money for our rowns; and the active evaluation of a massive programme of school rebuilding. This level of investment into the Calder Valley is unprecedented.

As I reflect on my 25 years in politics, including my time as a Parish and Borough Councillor, I recall that when I was first elected as your MP only envisaging serving for 2 terms. I only ever wanted to be a good local MP, not a career politician. When I look at what we have achieved in that time, I feel incredibly proud.

It is a huge privilege to represent Calder Valley in Parliament but Elaine and I have decided that we want to spend more qualify time together with our family. On that basis, and with huge pride in what we have achieved, tinged with sadness, I have decided that I will not be seeking re-election as your MP.

Rest assured, however, I have every intention of working vigorously for you right up until the General Election. I would like to thank you all for the huge levels of support and trust you have given me in my time as your MP. It truly has been an honour.

OVER £300M FOR OUR ROADS & TRAIN STATIONS

- £75.5M to improve safety on the A641, which stretches from Bailiff Bridge through to Rastrick.
- Over £20m for a new Elland Train Station
- £1.8m to repair Park Road, Elland.

 - New trains, platform extensions & signalling upgrades.
 - A new car park at Mytholmroyd Train Station.
